# **VOM**

## Veterinary Orthopedic Manipulation (Veterinary Chiropractic)

VOM is a non-invasive, non-painful chiropractic technique developed by veterinary surgeon Dr. William Inman in 1984. VOM utilizes the activator technique, a well-established, successful human technology to treat many musculoskeletal and orthopedic diseases of small animals.


#### What it treats:

- Neck pain
- Back pain
- Degenerative disc disease
- Spinal arthritis / spondylosis
- Other degenerative musculoskeletal diseases

### How it works:

The basis of this technology is the neurologic reduction of inflammation. By stimulating certain specific nerve endings we can induce the release of the body's own anti-inflammatory compounds.


Here's what's happening:



- 1 Injury stimulates pain
- 2 Pain stimulates muscle contraction, releasing products of inflammation: Histamine, Prostaglandins, Lactic Acid.
- 3 Inflammation causes swelling and edema, which causes more PAIN, which feeds back on pain receptors, starting the whole cycle over again.

THE GOAL OF ANY TREATMENT OPTION (SURGERY, MEDICATIONS, HOMEOPATHY, -\CUPUNCTURE, CHIROPRACTIC, MASSAGE THERAPY, TENS UNIT) IS TO STOP THE CYCLING INFLAMMATORY PROCESS AND INDUCE MUSCLE RELAXATION. Inflammation will cause continual release of toxic inflammatory products and will result in degeneration and arthritis.

This is our treatment model:



- 4 By stimulating other nerves called mechanoreceptors, we can turn off this repeating cycle of inflammation. VOM uses the activator (think of it as acupressure) to achieve this.
- 5 Mechanical input has the opposite effect of pain impulses (like relieving a leg muscle cramp by stretching out the muscle), releasing the body's own anti-inflammatory mediators: antiprostaglandins, endorphins, muscle relaxants, and vasodilators.
- 6 Muscle relaxation occurs, pain resolves, the body goes back to normal.

### What we do:

- a. The pet is evaluated to see if VOM is a possible treatment option.
- b. Various treatment options or combinations are discussed.
- c. VOM is started. Three "passes" with the acupressure device are made while watching for specific reflexes.
- d. An average of five to seven treatments are given over the following schedule:

<u>Treatment #</u>	<u>Given</u>
1	Day 1
2	1 week later
3	1 week later
4	2 weeks later
5	3 weeks later
6	4 weeks later
7	8 weeks later

Cost for the treatments is \$41.00 for the initial treatment, and \$31.00 for each additional session.

VOM is a safe, non-invasive, non-painful procedure that gives us another option in our efforts to keep pets with musculoskeletal pain more comfortable.
